



CAMPSITE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1/ ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In order to be allowed to enter, settle and stay on the campsite, you must be authorised by the Director or his representative. It is his duty to ensure that the campsite is kept in good order and orderly condition, and that the present rules of procedure are respected.

The fact of staying on the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these rules and regulations and the commitment to comply with them. Any person who has to stay at least one night on the campsite must first present to the Director or his representative, his identity papers, proof of address, and complete the formalities required by the police.

No one may take up residence on the campsite.

WEARING A BRACELET IS COMPULSORY. ANY PERSON CIRCULATING ON THE CAMPSITE WITHOUT THE BRACELET WILL BE EXPELLED.

2/ ANIMALS

To be admitted to the campsite dogs must be tattooed and vaccinated in accordance with current legislation. Guests will present the vaccination booklet at the reception where the dog will be listed. A maximum of 2 dogs are allowed.

Dogs must never be left at liberty but must be kept on a leash. They must not stay on the campsite (even locked up) in the absence of their owners who are civilly responsible for them. Access to the sanitary area is forbidden to dogs.

Dogs of 1st category are forbidden inside the campsite.

3/ INSTALLATION

The tent or caravan or motorhome or vehicle and the related equipment must be set up on the pitch indicated by the manager or his representative.

4/ ADVANCES

Prices are displayed at the entrance to the campsite. Fees are due according to the number of nights spent on the campsite. Users are invited to pay their fees on arrival.

5/ CAUTIONS

For a stay in a mobile home or a pitch with private sanitary facilities, a deposit will be required on your arrival at the reception desk by credit card or cash: 200€ for rentals and 50€ for pitches. The deposit will be returned on departure if there is no damage and the pitch is perfectly clean.

6/ CARE OF MOBILE HOMES AND LODGES RENTALS and PRIVATE HEALTH CARE

For hygienic reasons, smoking is not allowed inside the mobile homes and chalets.

The use of deep fryers is forbidden because of the greasy vapours and the risk of fire.

If the rental is left dirty, a cleaning fee will be charged: 80€.

The rental deposit will be retained in part or in full in the event of damage.

If the private bathroom is left dirty, a cleaning fee will be charged: 50€.

7/ MAINTENANCE OF THE FACILITIES

Everyone must contribute to the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite.

It is forbidden to throw waste water on the ground or in the alleys.

Household waste must be deposited in the containers provided for this purpose located after the sports ground. No deposits are allowed on the pitches.

Washing and mechanical maintenance of vehicles is forbidden on the campsite.

No construction is allowed on the pitches.

Any damage to the vegetation, fences, installations and equipment of the campsite will be at the expense of the author.

8/ INSURANCE

It is advisable to take out a cancellation insurance policy which could enable you to be reimbursed in the event of an event preventing you from making your stay. (See conditions of the insurer).

9/ OPTION

After a period of 8 days, without confirmation of the reservation by payment of a deposit, the reservation options, which have no contractual value, can be cancelled without penalty on either side.

10/ NOISE

Users of the campsite are asked to avoid any noise, discussions and games that might disturb their neighbours. Sound equipment must be adjusted accordingly. Door and boot locks should be as unobtrusive as possible. Silence must be total from 23:00 to 07:30.

11/ VEHICLES

Inside the campsite the vehicles must drive at a maximum speed of 10 Km/h.

Only vehicles belonging to the residents are allowed in the campsite.

The circulation of vehicles inside the campsite is forbidden from 23:00 to 07:30.

Vehicles must park on the allocated pitches (one vehicle per pitch) and must not hinder the installation of new arrivals.

12/ PLAYGROUND AND SWIMMING POOLS

The playground is accessible to children only under the supervision of their parents.

The paddling pool and swimming pool are also accessible to children only under parental supervision.

Bermuda shorts and floating shorts are prohibited.

In the event of an accident, the campsite management declines all responsibility.

13/ VISITORS

After having been authorised by the campsite manager or his representative, visitors may be admitted to the grounds of the campsite.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SWIMMING POOL

1 - Swimming pool capacity :

In the event of heavy traffic, access to the swimming pool may be temporarily suspended by the campsite staff.

2 - Opening :

The campsite's swimming pool is open on the same dates as the campsite.

Opening hours : 09 h - 19 h

The Management reserves the right to modify the opening hours or to close the swimming pool, in particular for technical, health or safety reasons.

3 - Dress and behaviour of users:

Swimming trunks are compulsory.

The wearing of long shorts, Bermuda shorts and T-shirts in the water is forbidden.

Swimming boxer shorts are accepted.

Guests must remain correctly and decently dressed.

Any act or behaviour that may affect the decency, good morals, the tranquillity of the bathers, the good order and cleanliness of the establishment is strictly forbidden. It will be punished by immediate dismissal from the pool.

It is forbidden to operate radio equipment, recorders or CD players and to take photographs without the consent of the persons concerned.

4 - Hygiene :

Animals are strictly forbidden in the pool area.

Showering, as well as the passage in the footbath, are obligatory when entering and leaving the pool.

It is forbidden to enter with shoes on your feet. Please leave them in the lockers in the entrance.

Access to the pools is forbidden to people suffering from illnesses whose external effects may cause discomfort or contagion to others, as well as to people in a state of obvious uncleanliness.

It is forbidden to eat, drink, smoke, chew gum, spit and throw rubbish in the pool area, rubbish bins are reserved for this purpose.

Only young children who are "clean" or equipped with special nappies are allowed to swim.

Every swimmer will ensure that the pool area is kept clean and tidy.

5 - Responsibility and supervision :

Access to the swimming pool is free and strictly reserved for the campsite's customers who must comply with the internal regulations.

The swimming pool is not supervised.

Minors must be accompanied by their parents, who are solely responsible for their supervision.

The management cannot be held responsible in the event of an accident.

6 - Security :

For their own safety, users of the swimming pool are requested to comply with the internal regulations.

It is forbidden :

- to bother the users with noisy, dangerous or immoral games or acts;
- to push or throw into the water people parked on the beaches;
- to run, shout, dive or throw water;
- to simulate drowning;
- playing ball or ball games on beaches;
- to enter forbidden zones indicated by signs or posters;
- to use floating objects and life buoys;
- to bathe with sun oil on your body;
- to climb fences and separations of any kind;

7 - Respect of the installations :

It is forbidden to damage the facilities and installations. Any damage or harm will be repaired at the expense of the offenders.

8 - Penalties :

The staff may exclude offenders from the pool at any time.

9 - Lost and Found :

The campsite is not insured against the loss or theft of jewellery, valuables or cash, even when handed in to the staff. Users are invited not to bring any objects to the campsite.
